Since their inception in 1999, the centres have evolved into vibrant locations for adult education, with over 500 students registered in day and evening courses during each school year.



The River East Transcona Adult Education Centres are committed to offering class-based instruction responsive to the unique needs of adult learners, sensitive to cross-cultural issues and barriers to learning, and relevant to the skill requirements for success in the workplace and post-secondary institutions.

## About Our Students

Our students generally enroll to take credits for one of three reasons:

### 1. **Manitoba Mature Student Diploma**

If you have never completed high school, you are not alone—25% of Manitobans have never graduated. Study with other adults in an adult-focused setting through our program. The Mature Student Diploma is for adults aged 19 plus - a fast-track, 8-credit, fully recognized high school diploma, featuring regular high school credits, including Grade 12 English and Mathematics. If you have high school marks from the past, certain credits may be carried forward. You may also receive credit for previous out-of-school learning.

### 2. **Regular High School Completion**

If you are 19 plus, and within a few credits of achieving your regular 30-credit diploma, get the credits you need to graduate through evening or day study.

### 3. **Academic Upgrading for Adults**

Your career goals may have changed since you graduated. Prepare for career advancement or post-secondary study through day or evening courses with either the McLeod or Transcona Centres. All Manitoba high school graduates are eligible to take up to four extra credit courses on a tuition-exempt basis.
