



# Can my child attend school after returning from travel?

**PLEASE NOTE: Public Health continues to recommend against non-essential travel**

## INTERPROVINCIAL TRAVEL

### ✓ Fully vaccinated travellers

Asymptomatic, fully vaccinated individuals aged 12 and older do not need to quarantine upon arrival in Manitoba and can attend school.

### ✓ Children under 12 travelling with fully vaccinated individuals

Children under 12 are not required to quarantine and can attend school if they are asymptomatic and all eligible individuals they are travelling with are fully vaccinated.

### ✗ Children under 12 travelling with individuals who are not fully vaccinated

If children under 12 are travelling with someone who is eligible but not fully vaccinated, they must quarantine for 14 days upon arrival back in the province.

### ✗ Unvaccinated travellers

Unvaccinated individuals aged 12 and over must quarantine for 14 days upon arrival in Manitoba.

## INTERNATIONAL TRAVEL (INCLUDING THE UNITED STATES)

### ✓ Fully vaccinated travellers

Asymptomatic, fully vaccinated individuals aged 12 and older do not need to quarantine upon arrival in Canada and can attend school.

### ✗ Children under 12 travelling with fully vaccinated individuals

Unvaccinated children under 12 travelling with fully vaccinated individuals do not need to quarantine, but must follow *enhanced public health measures*, including not attending school or daycare for 14 days upon arrival in Canada.

### ✗ Children under 12 travelling with individuals who are not fully vaccinated

If children under 12 are travelling with someone who is eligible but not fully vaccinated, they must quarantine for 14 days upon arrival in Canada.

### ✗ Unvaccinated travellers

Unvaccinated individuals aged 12 and over must quarantine for 14 days upon arrival in Canada.
