

# CRITICAL LEVEL (RED)

Teaching and learning remain a priority.

Schools are an important part of our community. We are committed to accommodating as many critical service workers' K-6 students as we safely can in our schools. All students will be engaged in remote learning, whether they are at home or in school.



## School updates:

- Remote learning for all students K-12 (no in-class learning) during duration of critical level (red)
- Students in K-6 of critical service workers and students with additional needs who have been identified by their schools may engage in remote learning at school
- All students and teachers will use Microsoft Teams
- Schools will be limiting access to staff, identified students and essential deliveries

## For students/staff engaged in remote learning in school:

- Students will be engaged with remote learning while inside the school
- Transportation continues for students identified for remote learning at school who normally take the bus
- Students will stay in school over the lunch hour with supervision provided
- Fundamentals such as handwashing, proper mask use, and physical distancing will continue to be taught and modelled
- Mask protocols continue for staff and students
- Students and staff are reminded to stay home if feeling unwell
