Dear Radisson School Staff:

The board of trustees wants to let you know how appreciative we are of the welcome you are extending to the students and staff of Westview School as they return to make your school their temporary home again.

The extensive damage—fire, water, smoke and structural—to Westview School will require several months' worth of construction to make the school habitable again. We know that unlike in the fall, Westview will not have the furnishings and supplies to transfer over to create a temporary home. We thank you for accommodating the students and staff in the midst of this turmoil.

Until we receive the official reports on the damage to the school only then will we know the approximate timeline that students and staff will be returning to Westview. Once we know more details on the timeline, we will let you know. In the meantime, please access RETSD website for up-to-date information www.retsd.mb.ca.

Please know the trustees—along with the senior administration and many others in the division as well as at your school—is making Westview School our number one priority and that includes accommodating Radisson School as it adjusts to the return of Westview.
