Dear Parents/Guardians,

Welcome to Kindergarten at Angus McKay School! The first day of school for Kindergarten students is Thursday, September 9th. **Kindergarten students will come for half a day on the first day of school.**

- Last name A-H will come in the morning (8:55-11:45 am)
- Last name I-Z will come in the afternoon (12:45-3:30 pm)

All Kindergarten students will come to school for full days starting Monday, September 13th. Please see the Kinder Ladybug Odd-Day Calendar for your child's school day schedule for the year.

We are asking that each family provide \$35.00 for school supplies that your child will use for the year. All the money collected will be used to purchase the school and craft supplies for the whole year, therefore, you will not need to supply your own. Your child will need to bring:

- Running shoes labelled with child's name – to be left at school (**slip on without laces, could be Velcro or bungee cords**)
- Large backpack (11" x 14" or bigger)
- Reusable lunch bag labelled with child's name that can fit in backpack
- An extra set of clothing – pants, underpants, t-shirt, and socks in a labelled Ziploc bag (to be left at school in case of accident!)
- Reusable water bottle
- 1 box of Kleenex
- Photo of child (wallet sized)
- Family photo (size: 4 x 6)

Please bring these items and the money or cheque made payable to Angus McKay School for the supplies on the first day of school.
