Dress for the Weather

Students are outside for recess and as much as possible, also for gym classes. Please make sure your child is dressed appropriately to spend that time outside. Slush pants, ski pants, boots, mitts and hats will make their active time outdoors much more enjoyable.

Remote Learning

Parents are reminded that when choosing the remote learning option, it is recommended by RETSD to commit to remote learning for 2 weeks. Our teachers are working very hard to plan and teach both in class and online. This 2-week commitment allows for our teachers to plan. We have also restructured our classrooms (even relocated some) so that we can create 2m distancing between students in the classroom. Students returning to school without notice creates a situation where we would need to address 2m distancing as students arrive. Depending on the number of students returning, we may need time to change classroom arrangements or even relocate a class if 2m distancing cannot be accommodated in the current location. If your wish is to have your child return to in-class learning, please contact your classroom teacher to determine a return date. Thank you for your support and cooperation.
