HOLD AND SECURE PRACTICE DRILL Monday, January 21, 2019

We will be practicing our Hold and Secure Drill on Monday, January 21st in the morning. A HOLD and SECURE will be activated if there is a *potential threat outside the school*. In these situations, the police typically contact the school and direct the school to go into Hold and Secure. When there is no longer a threat outside the school building, the police inform us that we can resume regular activities.

If our school is in Hold and Secure, the following procedures will apply:

- All exterior doors will be locked.
- NO ENTRY signs will be placed on each door.
- No one will be permitted to leave or enter the school until school administration announces that Hold and Secure is over.
- Classes and movement **within** the school continue as a regular day.
