Types of Awards



Awards – combination of academic achievement and financial need/school and community involvement



Scholarships – usually require a minimum average, community service, and in-school volunteering



Bursaries – based on financial need – will still be linked to conditions (G.P.A./attendance/registration)

U of W Scholarships

2022 Special Entrance Scholarships

- ▶ Currently there is an automatic award for Grade 12 students.
- ▶ Usually, admission should be complete by **March 1, 2022**.
- ▶ Eligibility: minimum of 85% Grade 12 award average (best 40s English, best 40s Math, one other 40s or 42S course), complete application by March 1, 2022, enroll in min. 12 credit hours for the fall
- ▶ have not received an award valued at more than \$5,000 from another source

- ▶ Deadline **February 1, 2022.**
- ▶ Ranges between \$100-\$48,000.
- ▶ Application-Required awards. Some will require nomination from KEC.
- ▶ **Both Entrance Award** and **admissions application** must be complete by March 1, 2022.

U of M Scholarships – general Entrance

- ▶ Must apply to the U of M by March 1st
- ▶ Students automatically selected based on **Final** Semester 1 and **Interim** Semester 2 marks – no adjustments for final marks
- ▶ Minimum average of 85% over the best five courses from a pre-approved list
