Scholarships:

Three Fairfax bursaries are available for students at the University of Manitoba. The bursary would require you to have a demonstrated financial need based on a government student loan assessment form, alongside a completed Fairfax Bursary application. You should also supply a letter outlining your extra-curricular involvement. For the complete criteria and the bursary application please see the scholarship notice board and/or visit Mr. White in the counselling area.

2019 Canada Post Awards for Indigenous Students are open for application. If you are a member of an indigenous community, have been out of school for one year or more, have recently returned to school and completed 1 year of study, and have never received this award you can complete an application. You will have to write an essay regarding your education, should supply transcripts, and should be able to officially confirm your indigenous identity. For more details see the Canada Post awards information on the scholarship notice board (outside Counselling offices) and/or see Mr. White.

LA LUPA DI ROMA LODGE has a scholarship available for Manitoba students of Italian descent entering full time post secondary studies. The scholarship is for \$1000. You will be required to complete the application form and an essay in addition to providing a transcript of marks, 2 letters of reference and a resume.
