Welcome to Lord Wolseley School. Your child will be staying at school for the full day when he / she is at Kindergarten. This means that your child could be staying at school during the lunch break, if that is what you choose.

Here are a few things to note:

Any student staying at Lord Wolseley School during the lunch break, even once, including students travelling by school bus needs to be registered with the Lord Wolseley School Lunch Program (LWSLP).

The LWSLP Committee provides on-site supervision of students staying at the school during the lunch break. As lunch breaks are a parental responsibility, if your child is not registered in the LWSLP you must make other arrangements for your child(ren) during the lunch break.

Please return a completed Registration Form for your child, along with the applicable post-dated cheques through the school office no later than **Wednesday, September 16, 2020**.

Please place your payment in a sealed envelope with your family name on the outside.

The user fee for a Kindergarten child registered as full time for the 2020 / 2021 school year is \$87.50. Information on registration and payment options can be found in Sections 1.03, 1.04 and 1.05 of the attached Registration Package.
