Dear Parent/Guardian

The River East Transcona School Division's policies state that the care and supervision of a child during the midday break is a parental responsibility. The division supports parent committees who establish and operate non-profit, user pay lunch supervision programs in our schools. To accommodate the childcare needs of families, the Maple Leaf School Lunch Program (MLSLP) is a non-profit small business run by a committee of parent volunteers. User pay fees are used to hire first-aid certified staff to supervise the students over the lunch period.

It is the school division's policy that your child(ren) must either:

- a) be registered in the lunch program or
- b) leave the school grounds for the duration of the lunch period (12:15 pm to 1:10 pm).

Staying for lunch, or being present on the school grounds during the lunch period, even one time, requires registration and payment of user pay fees.

Please find attached the lunch program registration package for the 2019-2020 school year. For registration options and fees, refer to the enclosed registration form. Take some time to familiarize yourself thoroughly with the program Policies and Rules.

Please complete one registration form for each family and submit the form(s) with applicable payment to the Maple Leaf School Lunch Program through the School office, no later than Monday, June 3, 2019.
