- Designated Driver Forms must be completed and returned Room 148 (Ms. Blazek's Room) during lunch on one of these dates.
- In exchange for a correctly completed Designated Driver Form, students will receive up to four
 Convocation tickets at no cost. The amount of tickets a student wishes to receive must be indicated on
 the Designated Driver Form.
- If a student will be attending Convocation but not the Dinner & Dance, they still must bring in the Designated Driver form with the amount of tickets requested for the Convocation.
- Students must clear any outstanding student fees and/or library fees or students will not receive Convocation tickets nor be able to purchase Dinner and Dance tickets.
- There will be a 24-hour wait to receive or purchase tickets once outstanding fees are settled.
- Returning the Designated Driver Form late will result in a \$10 price increase per Dinner & Dance ticket.
