TD SCHOLARSHIP FOR COMMUNITY LEADERSHIP

The TD Scholarship for Community Leadership award students up to \$70,000 for college or university (up to \$10,000 for tuition per year, \$75,00 a year for living expenses) for 4 years. It’s open to students across Canada who:

- have demonstrated community leadership, are in final year of high school
- have a minimum overall grade average of 75%

General Process:

- write a 600-word essay describing your community leadership experience
- a letter of recommendation from your school
- two letters of support from community groups AND a copy of your transcript
