SCHEDULE OF STUDENT FEES 2019-2020

Valley Gardens Middle School is pleased to offer special programs and events, which enhance and enrich student learning. Many of these initiatives require the collection of a fee. The following explains how these fees are used.

A. STUDENT FEES

\$40.00

- **Community Resource Days** - At Valley Gardens we promote the use of community resources to enhance student learning opportunities and experiences. CR days offer enrichment activities, which support the curriculum. Fees partially cover the cost of admissions and transportation to curricula related field trips, as well as any costs relating to in-school workshops and guest speakers.
- **Expressive & Applied Arts** - Used to cover part of the cost of supplies and materials for expressive and applied arts. (Those students who elect to complete a project/projects other than the recommended one, will be responsible for the cost of any additional materials.)
- **Miscellaneous Fees** - used to support student activities.

These fees do not cover the cost of lost or severely damaged textbooks. Most textbooks cost in excess of \$50.00. Students will be responsible for replacement costs of all lost or damaged textbooks.

B. BAND/GUITAR STUDENTS ONLY

\$30.00

Band/Guitar Students are required to pay an additional fee of \$30.00 to help facilitate the running of the program. Expenses that are covered include music books, performance shirts, guitar strings (for guitar players) and other sundry items.

C. YEARBOOK (optional)

\$25.00

Each year the students have the option of purchasing a yearbook. These must be pre-paid in order for us to plan for the appropriate number of books. Most students look forward to this record of the school year.

D. SUPPLEMENTARY ACTIVITIES
