

CONDUCT AT BOARD MEETINGS

- (1) No member shall disobey the rules of the board or a decision of the chair or of the board on any question or order to practice or upon the interpretation on the rules of the board; and in case a member persists in any such disobedience after having been called to order by the chair, the chair shall forthwith put the question, with no amendment, adjournment or debate being allowed, “That such member be ordered to leave his/her seat for the duration of the meeting of the board”, but if the member apologizes he/she may, by vote of the board, be permitted to retake his/her seat.
- (2) No member shall use offensive words or speak disrespectfully in or against the board, or against any member.
- (3) No member shall have the power to direct or interfere with the performance of any work for the board; and the officer in charge shall be subject only to his/her superior officer (if any), and to the board, or to any committee (while acting in that capacity and not otherwise) to which the board may in any case give authority in that behalf.
- (4) No member shall speak disrespectfully of the reigning sovereign, or of any of the royal family, or of the governor general, or of the lieutenant governor or of any person administering the executive government of Canada or of any province of Canada.
